Behaviours in Year 1 and Year 2 (KS1)

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are aware there have been several low level behaviour incidents within KS1 over the last couple of weeks. As a school, we have high behaviour expectations of all of our children. Following the incidents that have arisen, we wish to reassure parents/carers of the steps we are taking to address them.

All classes have been spoken by their class teachers, rules and expectations have been reiterated and discussions have been had during assembly time so that all children have received the same message about behaviour, making good choices and the difference between right and wrong.

In addition to this, all classes take part in weekly PSHE lessons. This half term, children have been focusing on 'celebrating differences'. Children have learnt about who to talk to if they feel unhappy at school, what to do if someone says or does something they do not like and they have regular circle time discussions about what different strategies they can use if needed. Children are encouraged to share their feelings through the use of 'colour monsters'. This helps staff to identify any children who may need some time to talk or additional support in managing their feelings.

As always, we value your support and co-operation. Please do speak with your child at home to reinforce our school's high expectations of behaviour. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you that we have an open-door policy and staff are happy to discuss any questions or issues you may have at any time.
