- **Small Group Access**: Children will be organized into small groups to facilitate effective learning and ensure close supervision.



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Proximity to Changing Facilities: Convenient changing facilities will be located nearby, allowing
for a smooth transition before and after the swimming sessions. All children will need to wear
swimming caps and staff will support with putting these on.

We want to emphasize that the safety and well-being of your children are our top priorities. We have worked diligently to create an environment that meets the highest safety standards.

National Curriculum requirements for swimming.

You must provide swimming instruction either in Key Stage (KS) 1 or KS2. This is set out in the National Curriculum's programme of study for physical education.

This should include teaching pupils to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke
- Perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

The requirements apply even if your school's age range doesn't cover all of KS1 and KS2, so infant, junior, first and middle schools must still provide swimming instruction, according to the DfE.
