As we approach the end of the school year, I wanted to take a moment to express my appreciation for all your support and involvement following the successful launch of the 1:1 device project in September last year.

I have outlined some key points to note regarding the devices before the term ends.

**All devices, cases and apple chargers and leads** need to be returned to Ashbrook school by **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July at the latest**.

Please note, **any damaged or missing accessories will incur charges**.

This is a deadline set by the Trust and it is important to note that all devices will need to remain in school, so they can be wiped off remotely, ready for the next cohort.

I will be speaking to the children about how they can keep an online portfolio of their work from this year. This can then be viewed online on a tablet or laptop. I will also be sending home a guide on how you can support your child to select pieces of work as part of their learning portfolio.
